Title 1 Information for City Academy Parents:

City Academy is designated as a Title I School. Title I is a federal program which focuses additional funding on our school. This funding is based on the socio-economic status of our student body. Title I designation allows City Academy funding to provide basic skills classes in language arts and math, the ALEKS software program for individualized mathematics development, and professional development for the director, teachers and paraprofessionals who work with your students. Part of fulfilling our Title I obligations is to let you know that as a parent of a student at City Academy you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers who instruct your child.
