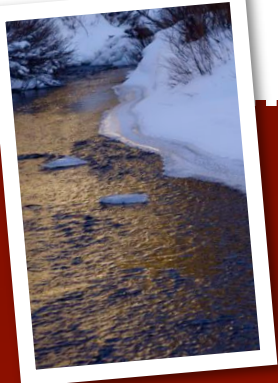

Front Desk-Sara: Feminine supplies, basic school supplies, Battery Charger
