this year. The classes will take place at City Academy from June 12-July 1. Students will have the opportunity to make up credit for Math and English classes, with alternative

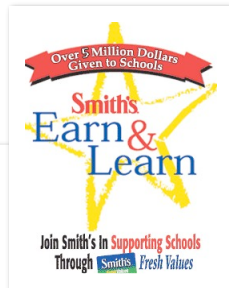
options available for other courses. You can pre-register for these classes with Sara at the front desk. A 10% discount will be given if registered by June 6.

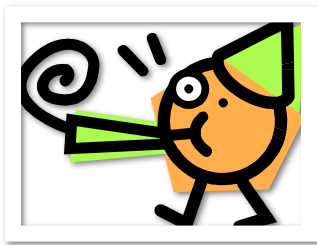
