develop the school community and support City Academy. Everyone is encouraged to contribute ideas for discussion at the monthly meetings.

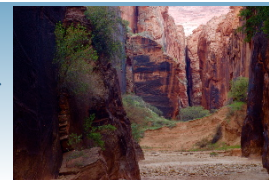

City Academy's Annual Thanksgiving Feast!

The Social Committee is planning its third annual Thanksgiving Feast for Wednesday, November 21 at 12:30. This luncheon is held to help foster a sense of community within our school by bringing everyone together for a community meal. The best thing is, thanks to parent and local business donations, the meal is free for students! The Social Committee would like to ask for your help - of donations and time.

Time needs:

- Tuesday, November 20 from 3:00-? to help the committee prepare everything
- Wednesday, November 21 for shifts between 11:30-2:00 to help with serving and cleanup

Here are the items that are needed by the committee:

- **4 large turkeys (or turkey breasts/thighs/etc.)**- cooked (the committee asks that turkeys, if at all possible, be prepared at your home to facilitate time and space usage constraints. If the turkeys can be sliced, that would be exceptionally helpful as this year we are doing most preparations after school on Tuesday rather than all day Sunday) (**We have 4 turkey breasts so far**)
- **cans of green beans** (we have 8 pounds so far)
- **cream of mushroom soup and fried onions for green bean casserole**
- **cans of mixed vegetables**
- **gravy packets or jars**
- **potatoes for making mashed potatoes** (we have about 15 pounds so far)
- **cornstarch**
- **cartons of eggs**
- **milk or cream** (we have one quart whipped cream)
- **apple cider**
- **cookies**
- **stuffing** (ingredients or pre-made) (we have one casserole so far)
- **onions**
- **rolls**
- **butter/margarine**
- **bags of salad** (we have 2 bags so far)
- **salad dressings**
- **serving trays for the food** (we have 3 trays so far)
- **paper plates**

* Students will still have the option of signing up for the regular school lunch if desired.
