The best thing is, thanks to parent and local business donations, the meal is free for students! The Social Committee would like to ask for your help - of donations and time.

### Time needs:

- Tuesday, November 20 from 3:00-? to help the committee prepare everything
- Wednesday, November 21 for shifts between 10:45-3:00 to help with serving and cleanup

### Here are the items that are needed by the committee:

- 4 large turkeys - cooked (the committee asks that turkeys, if at all possible, be prepared at your home to facilitate time and space usage constraints. If the turkeys can be sliced, that would be exceptionally helpful as this year we are doing most preparations after school on Tuesday rather than all day Sunday)
- cans of green beans
- cream of mushroom soup and fried onions for green bean casserole
- cans of mixed vegetables
- gravy packets or jars
- cans of yams
- cranberry sauce
- potatoes for making mashed potatoes
- cornstarch
- cartons of eggs
- milk or cream
- apple cider
- tofurkeys (for the vegetarians/vegans in our community)
- cookies
- stuffing (ingredients or pre-made)
- onions
- rolls
- butter/margarine
- bags of salad
- salad dressings
- serving trays for the food (disposable o.k.)
- paper plates
