Script Writers Wanted

The City Academy Theatre Company is looking for student-written scripts for our production of 10 minute plays on **January 29th, 2011.**

Submission guidelines

10 MINUTE PLAY CONTEST- ENTRY RULES

- Only original plays, never before produced, are eligible.
- The play, exclusive of title and cast pages, may be no more than ten pages.
- Play should have 2-4 characters and minimal props and costumes.
- Assemble script as follows for submission:

TWO COPIES OF THE PLAY

Optional cover letter.

A title page with the play's title, author's name, address, phone number, and email address. (This is the only place the author's name should appear.)

The second page should contain a cast of characters and time and place information.

The third page will be the first page of the script. The other pages of the play follow.

Name of the play and page numbers on every page.

- The play, exclusive of title and cast pages, may be no more than ten pages. Name of the play and page numbers on every page of the play.
- Staple or paper clip the play. Do NOT use binders or folders of any kind.
- Six winners will be chosen.
- All authors agree to permit City Academy Theatre Company to produce their submitted play(s). Authors retain copyright and full ownership of their plays.
- Authors may submit multiple plays.

Deadline: Submissions must be on or before **January 5, 2011.**
No exceptions.
