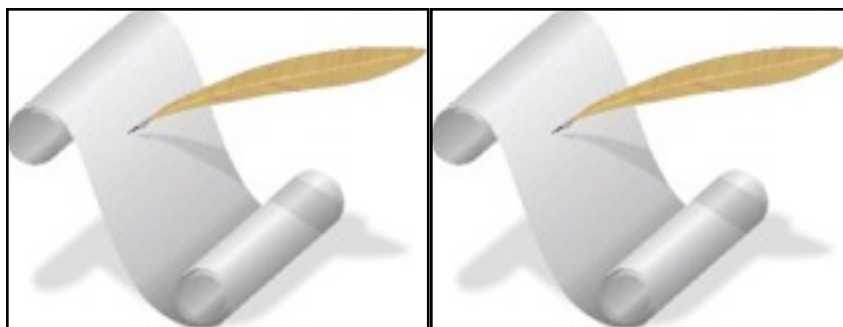
Parents – Pre-Register for 2010-2011 Now!

We want all of our current students back for next year and the time for you to ensure that is now! City Academy will be holding our 2010-2011 new student enrollment lottery on Friday, February 19th. Please make sure you have turned in pre-registration forms by February 19 to reserve your place at City Academy for next year.

After February 19th we will be filling any open places for students with new students from the lottery. The quality teaching, curriculum, and programs that currently make our school special will continue. We are also excited to add new elective classes along with offering a new selection of the internationally recognized Cambridge International Examinations (CIE) courses for high school students.

As always, we are happy to welcome siblings of current City Academy students to our community next year. Any siblings of currently enrolled City Academy students who are in good standing at their current school and who complete the pre-registration process for school year 2010-11 by Friday February 19th, will have first priority for potential enrollment for 2010-11.
