Illustration Class – Taught by artist and art teacher Jo Bradbury

Aspiring artists of all skill levels will gain an introduction to Illustration by hand. It will be an exploration of skills including pen, pencil shading, inking and painting. We will also be conceptually centered, by exploring the act of “*Illustrating*” a written word, mood, or idea. Students will focus on how to show narrative by utilizing RELATIONSHIPS of imagery within a picture plane. Students will come away from Illustration Summer Studio with improved drawing and observation skills, as well as a basic understanding of how to illustrate the written word. They will also come away with at least one, completed illustration. Tuition includes in depth demonstrations and one on one instruction, as well as a process-based experience that will stay with you for the rest of your life!
