General Fee Information	<p>1. Any payment for student participation in a class, program, or activity is a fee and is subject to the fee waiver requirement. For information on fee waivers and other details, contact the school director.</p> <p>2. All students are responsible to pay for any loss, breakage, or damage they cause to school property. Loss breakage, or damage is not subject to the fee waiver requirement.</p> <p>3. Students may be required to participate in group fundraising.</p> <p>4. Donations are permissible, but all such requests are voluntary. A student may not be excluded from an activity or program because they did not make a donation</p> <p>5. The maximum annual amount that a student may be charged is \$1,000. The actual amount charged per student may be less.</p>	
Basic Fee Middle School	\$170	Materials, supplies, clothing, instructional equipment, food, and access to software, digital content, instructional materials, textbooks, lab equipment, field work, field trips, and school activities which are provided in order for students to participate fully at school and to have the opportunity to acquire all skills and knowledge required for full credit and academic advancement. Additionally included with high school fees: Cambridge program costs and IGCSE exam fees.

Remedial courses and credit recovery	\$50 Per 9 weeks	Enrolled in Edgenuity to complete as many credits as possible in 9 weeks. If student completes at least 0.5 credit in the 9 weeks then \$25 will be applied to the next 9 weeks, or refunded if make-up work is complete. Fees not subject to fee waiver.
