3. A review of Title I School Improvement Plan (SIP) Goals:
 - Goal 1: Improve student achievement from 54% in Q1 2020 to at least 80% of students passing all their core academic classes in Q4 2021, with a goal of achieving a rate of at least 90%.
 - Goal 2: Improve USBE graduation rate from 69% in 2019 toward a goal of 90%.
 - 2020 USBE grad rate = 71% (includes 3/21 undocumented student transfers)
 - 2020 grad rate for enrolled students = 83%
 - Goal 3: Keep annual student transfer rate < 15% and maintain student year-to-year retention rate at 75% or higher.
 - How are we identified as a Title I school?
 - Funding to help ensure improved SIP goal progress through use of Title I funds to help support a full time counselor, for job-embedded professional development particularly for new teachers, and to support an instructor for the supported-study program in support of improved student attainment in English and Math.
